





### ST. JOHNS FIRE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT

#### #31 2017 Custom Spartan Chassis Metrostar with a Cummins Engine - Radio Equipped

This unit is a top mount pumper/tanker that holds 2,000 gallons of water. This unit is used for both city and country fire runs. It pumps 1,500 gallons a minute and is equipped with a CAFS unit (compressed air foam system). This truck also carries a set of JAWS equipment.

#### #32 2011 Ford F550 Rosenbauer Light Duty Rescue - Radio Equipped

This unit is used on both city and country fires as well as rescue runs. This truck has a Class A foam system, 75-gallon water tank, remote control light tower and carries extrication and rescue equipment as well as spare air bottles.

#### #33 1996 Dodge RAM 2500 Brush Truck - Radio Equipped

This unit is used for brush/grass fires. It has an aluminum flatbed, 250 gallon poly water tank and two 50' booster hose lines.

#### #34 2023 Spartan -- Radio Equipped

This unit is used on all city and country fires. Class A pumper with a 1,000 gallon water tank, 1,500 gpm pump, firefighting equipment, and thermal imaging camera.

#### #35 2019 Polaris Ranger--Radio Equipped

This unit is used for brush/grass fires. It carries 50 gallons of water and has a 50' booster reel.

#### #350 1984 E-One Chassis--Radio Equipped

Equipped with aerial device to reach 80 feet. Carries equipment for major firefighting, rescue, ventilation, and pumping, has 300 gallon water tank.

#### #300 2021 Ford F-150

Responds to each and every incident. Used as a command post at the scene. Put into service December 2021.
