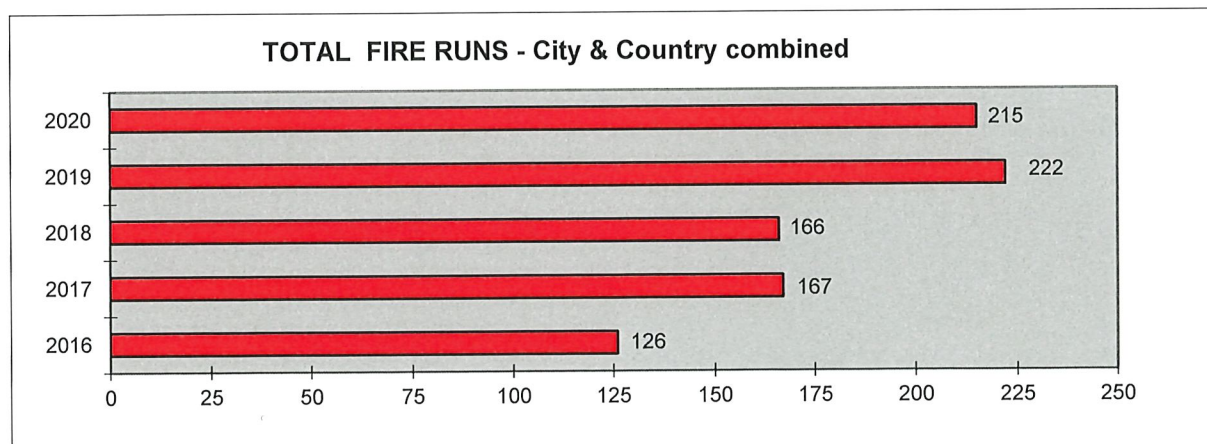
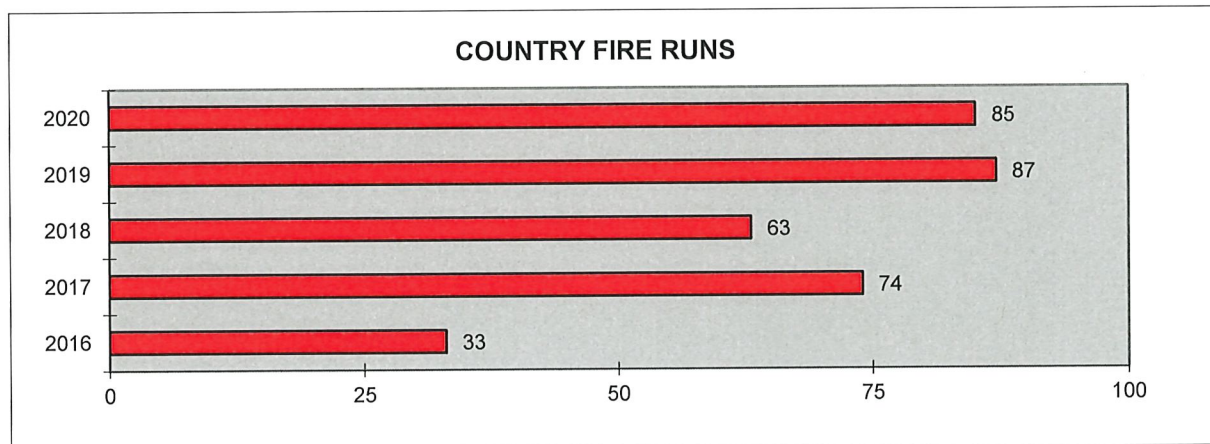
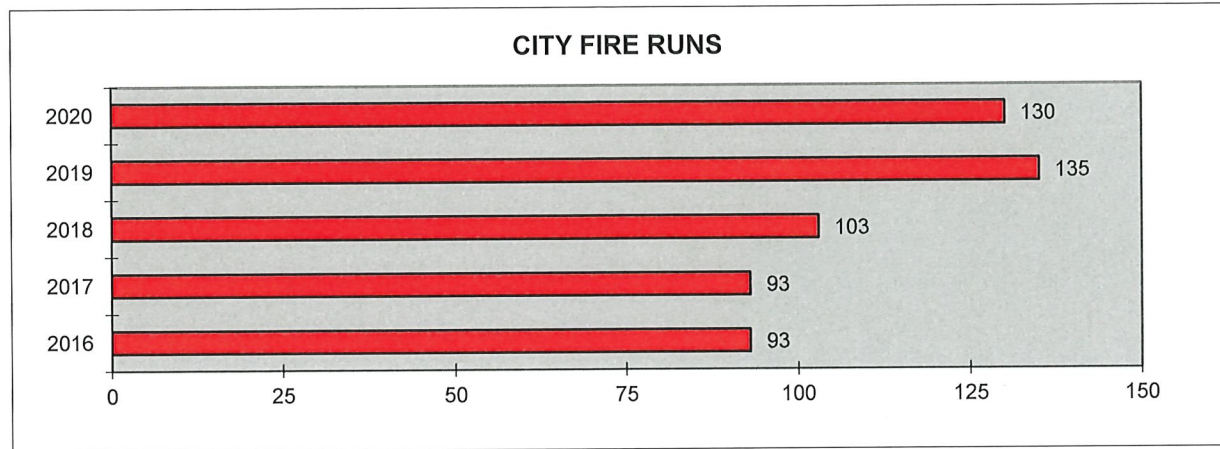

EQUIPMENT

#31 2017 Custom Spartan Chassis Metrostar with a Cummins Engine - Radio Equipped

This unit is a top mount pumper/tanker that holds 2,000 gallons of water. This unit is used for both city and country runs. It pumps 1,500 gallons a minute and is equipped with a CAFS unit (compressed air foam system). This truck also carries a set of JAWS equipment. This truck is in new condition.

#32 2011 Ford F550 Rosenbauer Light Duty Rescue - Radio Equipped

This unit is used on both city and country fires as well as rescue runs. This truck has a Class A foam system, 75-gallon water tank, remote control light tower and carries extrication and rescue equipment as well as spare air bottles. Put into service in June 2011, this truck is in new condition.

#34 2006 F550 Ford Chassis--Radio Equipped

This unit is used on all city and country fires. Class A pumper with CAFS unit (compressed air foam system), has 300 gallon water tank, foam and firefighting equipment. This truck is in new condition.

#350 1984 Hendrickson Chassis--Radio Equipped

Equipped with aerial device to reach 80 feet. Carries equipment for major firefighting, rescue, ventilation and pumping, has 300 gallon water tank. Very good condition. This truck was delivered in December 1995.

#300 2007 GMC Yukon

Responds to each and every incident. Used as a command post at the scene. Put into service August 2006.
