CITY OF ST. JOHNS ORDINANCE NO. 671

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 30.09 (OF TITLE III, CHAPTER 30) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO AMEND RULES FOR ADDRESSING THE COMMISSION

The following Ordinance was moved by Commissioner Ruestman and supported by Commissioner Gurski at a regularly scheduled public meeting on September 26, 2022:

THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Purpose.</u> It is the purpose of this Ordinance to amend the City's Code of Ordinances to the Commission to adopt reasonable rules for public comment.

<u>Section 2.</u> Amendment to Section §30.09. Section 30.09 of Chapter 30 (entitled *City Commission*) of Title III (entitled *Administration*) the Code of Ordinances of the City of St. Johns, entitled, *Addressing the Commission*, is amended as follows:

§30.09 ADDRESSING THE COMMISSION

Persons are welcome at all City Commission meetings that are open to the public pursuant to law and are encouraged to attend. A person must be permitted to address a meeting of the City Commission under rules established and recorded by the City Commission.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Validity and Severability</u>. If any portion of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance shall be found to be invalid by a court, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid portion or applications, provided the remaining portions are not determined by the court to be inoperable, and to this end Ordinances are declared to be severable.

<u>Section 4.</u> Repealer Clause. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after final approval.
